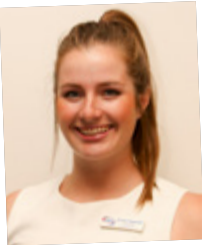

EDITORIAL WEEK 8

As we pass the mid-season hump and roll into the second half of the football year, it's been pleasing to see such a reduction in the average winning margins in our senior competitions.

Compared to the same time last season, there has been a significant drop in the average winning margins across all three senior divisions, some results reduced by more than 50 per cent.

In Rounds 1-8 this season, the Division One senior competition has seen an average reduction of 15.1 points a game, Division Two has been reduced by 51.1 points while the Division Three competition margin was cut by more than half, falling from 111.7 points in 2014 to 41.6 points.

The reductions have not only produced a more even competition, but has all tipping experts left guessing as to who will take home the chocolates each weekend as our clubs battle it out for finals positions. For a more in depth look at the competition evenness, be sure to flick to page 3.

In case you thought the rate of female football in the west was on the decline, think again, with the introduction of the inaugural Newport Power Junior Football Club Youth Girls team.

Recruiting over a dozen young women aged from 13-18 years, the new team is not only the first of its kind in the Hobsons Bay municipality, but is also embracing its cultural diversity in the community with many of the players coming from a Muslim background.

REDUCED MARGINS CLOSE THE GAP



The introduction of the Western Region Football League's new Division Three competition has seen a significant reduction in average winning margins this season, some by more than 50 per cent.

With the successful introduction of Werribee Districts and Tarneit Football Clubs in 2014, the league was split into three senior divisions after 13 rounds of football last year to create 10 (Division One), eight (Division Two) and six-team (Division Three) competitions.

Since the split, all three divisions have had significant reductions in average winning margins across the first eight rounds of football in 2015 compared to the same time last season.

In Division One, the senior competition has seen an average reduction of 15.1 points a game and the reserves competition has also been reduced by approximately two goals.

The average winning margin in the Division Two senior competition has been reduced by 51.1 points while the Division Three senior competition margin was cut by more than half, falling from 111.7 points in 2014 to 41.6 points.

In one case study, the total margin for Round 5 in Division Two last season was 1,024 points. Twelve months on, and that figure has been cut back to 254 points in Division Two and 182 points in Division Three.

WRFL chief executive Bob Tregear said that the reductions already seen this season was proof that the new Division Three tier has delivered a more even competition.

"While some clubs weren't too keen on being relegated to Division Three when it was initially introduced, it has provided all clubs with a great opportunity to play at a more competitive level."

While the recent Community Club Sustainability Program proposal by the AFL Vitoria Equalisation Working Party will help regulate more equal competition across the state next season, the work conducted by the WRFL Strategic Planning Committee over the past four years has in itself led to impressive margins.

"Our 2010-2014 Strategic Planning committee worked really hard on providing a more even competition structure and to get the league in a position where three divisions was possible has been a major contributor of these margin reductions," Tregear said.

The decline in margins in excess of 100 points across all three divisions has also been reduced compared to the same time last year, with a drop of 57 instances in 2014 to just 25 occasions this year.

"Big margins over 100 or 200-points affects all clubs no matter what side of the results you fall on, so the fact that we have been able to reduce them this season is outstanding," Tregear said.

Start-up clubs as well as clubs who have traditionally struggled for wins each season have seen the benefits of the third tier, none more so than North Sunshine.

"The split last year gave our Reserves the opportunity to gain some finals experience, which we haven't had in a long time, so we could see the benefits of Division Three in its early stages," North Sunshine Vice President Paul Comino said.

Recording just 19 wins over the past decade, North Sunshine has already chalked up two wins this season sitting in seventh place on the ladder, while its reserves have won three matches and sit in fifth place.

"There's a positive feeling down at the club at the moment.

"Some of our losses this year have been close matches, so we will be taking that confidence into the second half of the season.

"From a committee point of view, we are really pleased with how the club is travelling and feel like we are coming out of the hard times.

"We have the patience to keep improving each year and while we know that we won't win every game, we are determined to get better each week and be competitive, which the new division has allowed us to do."

ST.ALBANS NEW FIDA TEAM

One thing is for certain and that is that football doesn't discriminate. The game that we watch, play, or volunteer at has no requirements for participation. Whether you are supporting your local team, playing at club level, or cheering on your favourite players, acceptance and inclusion are some of the reasons which makes our game so great.

Football brings communities and people from all walks of life together, which is where the St. Albans Football Club's new FIDA (Football Integration Development Association) team is helping lead the way.

For St. Albans FIDA coach, Ian MacKenzie, a chance meeting with SCOPE was the inspiration behind the idea to get a St Albans FIDA team up and running this season.

"A couple of years ago I was president of the cricket club and through our sports club manager Keith Barnard, a disability support group called SCOPE approached us to do a cricket abled body clinic and run a bit of a training session in the nets which we did with all our cricketers.

"We then had a presentation night a couple of years ago at Princess Park for a program called Balloon Football which allows people in wheelchairs to play football and that's when I met Logan who runs the FIDA competition.

"I spoke to him after the presentation night and found out more about what FIDA is and what was required and said I wanted to get involved.

"It's taken us a couple of years to get it going along with fellow organiser Nick Brown, but we're really proud to finally get a team together."

Established in 1990, FIDA has been providing a program of Australian Football for over 400 people with an intellectual disability throughout Victoria.



Players involved in FIDA enjoy an environment that not only promotes fitness, friendships and sense of belonging, but more importantly, enhances

the players' life skills and develops self-esteem.

While a number of other WRFL clubs also have FIDA teams competing in the fortnightly competition, St.Albans is the first club in the Brimbank municipality to provide a FIDA team for people in its community.

Despite the Saints only having five players registered with the team thus far, it doesn't stop the smile on the faces of the guys donning their football gear and having a kick.

"While we are down on numbers, we just mix the teams up and have a bit of fun," MacKenzie said. "We play St Francis next week and when we played them a couple of weeks back before one of our senior games on the Saturday, they had a couple of abled bodied guys just join in and help us out...which we had an absolute ball doing."

While the rules of the game are slightly modified, don't be mistaken, the St.Albans boys go in hard at the footy, from handballing, to shepherding and even kicking goals as they emulate their AFL heroes.

Given that St. Albans' FIDA team has just started, volunteers are an essential part in making sure that the squad has a solid foundation to grow from in the future. NEWPORT YOUTH GIRLS TEAM

If anyone thought the rate of female football was on the decline in the western suburbs, think again, with the introduction of the latest Youth Girls team from the Newport Power Junior Football Club.

Celebrating its 10th Anniversary this season, Newport Power is proud to establish its tenth team this year, with its inaugural Youth Girls side running out for the first time last weekend.

Open to all girls aged between 13-18 years old, the new side has already recruited more than a dozen interested players all keen to pull on the boots and learn new skills.

As the only Aussie Rules Youth Girls team in the Hobsons Bay municipality, Club President Stephen Martyn said that the team was a great opportunity for women looking to try something new.

“Offering the opportunity for women to now play football at our club is fantastic for those who want to be involved in a more physical, free running type of sport. I’m sure there are many young women who would enjoy the experience of playing competitive football in a well organised competition which will only continue to grow, so we welcome any girls from Hobsons Bay and surrounding areas to become part of our new team.”

Despite the 2015 season already underway, Gilmore Girls College student Sara Elhouli approached the club with the idea to establish a youth girls team after she was encouraged by one of her school teachers.

“Sara mentioned she liked Newport Power as a club as her younger brother Shakille plays in our Under 10’s team and she was familiar with the clubs values and environment,” Martyn said. “After receiving confirmation from the league and other relevant parties, the team was on the hunt for players.”

Since putting the call out to women last month, 15 players have signed up to participate this season, with the majority of players coming from Gilmore Girls College.

With a large proportion of the Youth Girls team coming from a Muslim background, the club has been supportive of some of the girls’ decision to wear conservative headwear whilst playing competitively.

“As a club we have always catered for all members needs from day one as much as possible and are always trying to improve on all aspects as time

goes on,” Martyn said.

After a number of weekly training sessions under coaches David Grubits, Gordon Mutch, assistant coach Nazih Abdo and team manager Kate Matheson, the new side played its first competitive match last Saturday against fellow WRFL Youth Girls team Point Cook.

“The girls certainly didn’t hold back or shirk a contest, which was great to see as it was their first attempt at non-school competitive football,” Martyn said. “Point Cook are in their second year, which showed throughout the game, but our girls didn’t let us down with many linked passages of play and lots of entertaining moments, which was rewarding for all involved.”

Despite the score line, Martyn says that this was just the first step in the progression and development of not only the Youth Girls team, but for the club in general.

“As a club we originally set out 11 years ago to re-engage with the younger children in the area and provide a healthy option in recreation activities.

“We are working extremely hard with the WRFL, Hobsons Bay City Council and others to secure a second ground with illumination capabilities to ensure our growth can continue in an orderly fashion, with a planned 12-14 teams next year.

“In doing this we hope to continue to build on the creation of this new female team and don’t want to set any limits on the number of women’s Youth Teams we can offer.”

There are some footballers who, after completing a fair career, decide to remain involved in football by turning their hand to umpiring. The VFL, in pre-AFL years, has a long list of 85 former VFL players crossing over to blow the whistle out in the middle or wave flags.

At present, there are two former AFL footballers officiating as field umpires at the highest level. Both Jordan Bannister and Leigh Fisher were appointed to the AFL field umpiring panel in 2012. Bannister played 14 games for Essendon (2001-2003) and a further 53 games for Carlton (2004-2009). Fisher played 55 games for St.Kilda between 2003 and 2008.

Just last week, Bob Madigan called into Scovell Reserve to say hello to some of the older brigade of umpires. Bob was a familiar figure as a field umpire in the FDFL throughout the 1970s and 1980s clocking up approx 350 games. He had a brief local football career but a small frame meant that he was injury prone and so he made the switch to umpiring.

Of the present WRFL umpires those with the most prominent football careers would have to be Terry McGarity and Andrew Fregonese. Terry coached Spotswood to a couple of premierships after playing in the VFA. Andrew served the West Footscray Football Club as a junior up into the senior ranks. Both Terry and Andrew have now been umpiring for many years. Their experience and the ability to change as football and rules have developed and evolved means that they are still an important part of the umpiring fraternity. One valid point is that, even though they may be in the twilight of their umpiring careers, they often find themselves in the position to coach, instruct and assist the younger and developing group of umpires.

As Mark Westgarth has often said about umpiring in the WRFL, "There are no coaches. We are all coaches." Even so, many of the experienced and long-serving umpires in the WRFL share their knowledge with those of the younger generations each week across all three umpire disciplines which not only develops the juniors, but more importantly strengthens the team as a whole.

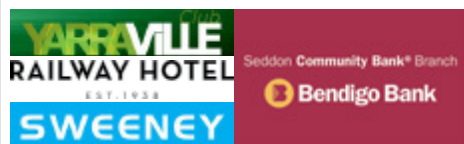

With the top three sides setting the pace coming out of the Queen's Birthday break, fourth and fifth spots will be hotly contested as teams attempt to round out the remaining finals places.
