JAKE SMITH Albanvale Football Club



While it takes many junior players a number of years to chalk up 100 games, it took Albanvale Football Club's Jake 'Sticks' Smith just five football seasons to reach his 100th milestone earlier this year.

Running onto the field to play Sunshine in Round 9 this season, Sticks became the club's youngest player to chalk up 100 games at age 11.

Smith has been pulling on the boots with the

WRFL since 2011 where he started his career in the Cobra's Under 10 Blue team.

During this time, 11-year-old Smith has achieved more than most his age, many only reaching 100 games at 14 or 16.

Smith's talent on field is evident with him twice coming runner up in Albanvale's best and fairest and also placing in the WRFL's best and fairest award on two occasions over the past two years.

Despite Albanvale's U13C yet to win a game this season, it is Smith along with teammate Justin Powell who are leading the goal kicking tally with five goals each.

While his milestone match was an exciting moment for Sticks and his family, it was not just his team who were supportive of this achievement, but many of the senior Albanvale players, with many going down to the match and even offering to run the water.

Having already achieved 100 games in his short career, it seems Sticks has a promising future ahead of him, with many more games to come.

MASSIMO D'AMBROSIO Point Cook Football Club



If the five WRFL senior players selected in the AFL Vic Metro squad demonstrated a healthy amount of talent in the league, it's warming to know the grooming of talent is being seen a lot further down the chain with its juniors.

Point Cook youngster Massimo D'Ambrosio has been selected

for the Primary Schools Boys squad that will represent Victoria at the Australian Championships this month.

Despite having just celebrated his 12th birthday in June, Massimo already has quite a resume winning back to back league best and fairest medals (2013-2014) and captaining the Point Cook Under 11A premiership team last year.

"I am honoured in being selected as one of the team to play for Victoria," Massimo said. "To wear the Big V is a surreal feeling and it's something I have wanted for a long time. It's a dream come true and I can't wait for the championships to start."

Selection into this squad is by no means an easy feat, as his father Louie D'Ambrosio explained.

"The selection process began in March to make the final team of 23. You go through seven different trials stages which include Primary School trials, District, Division, Region, Metro, Metro and Country combined and final selection for the State Team which comprises students from all over Victoria. You compete in a series of competitions conducted by School Sport Victoria to gain selection in the Victorian State Team."

Competing against teams from across the country, all state teams play each other in a round robin style format across the week commencing July 20, with the semi-finals and final played at the end of the week, and the closing ceremony on July 25.

We wish Massimo and all WRFL players involved well at the Championships.

F&Y SOCIALS REUNION

As the old saying goes, you never truly appreciate what you have until it's gone.

While the football season is a hectic time for many club officials, players and volunteers, it is the hard work and effort which goes into making a football club which is what many of us will hold onto, years after we hang up the boots.

One group who continues to hold onto their football days is the reunion committee of the Footscray and Yarraville Socials Football Club.

Originating from the small housing community of Seddon when the Footscray and Yarraville Social and Education Club was formed in 1933, the football club's relationship with the FDFL/WRFL began in 1945 where they became a dominant figure within the league.

A mere five years since its formation, the F&Y Socials became a powerful unit during the late 1950s and early 60s, winning three consecutive premierships (1959-61) as well producing 31

champion players and umpires, many of who went on to be state and Australian representative players.

Since going into recess in 1975, former players Barry Bennett, Max Linehan and its committee have been working hard to ensure that the memory of the club and its members continues to live on.

"Four decades on, members still have that strong will to continue relationships forged in the past," Bennett said.

"While it's not always easy getting in touch with many of the players from that era, we have over 50 past players and officials come down every year for our annual reunion which is fantastic."

This year's function will once again be held at Barkers Café located at Whitten Oval on Friday July 31.

Kicking off from 11:30am, guests will enjoy a supreme BBQ luncheon, with drinks at bar prices. Cost will be \$30 per person.

"A lot of our members either no longer have a connection with the WRFL anymore or have moved away from the area, so this reunion is a chance for them to still know that their contribution to the sport has not been forgotten and is an opportunity for everyone to reconnect with people they haven't seen in years," Bennett said.

"While we enjoy catching up with the F&Y Social people, we are looking to extend our annual reunion to include other teams and identities who were part of history playing in the FDFL."

RICE TO DON THE BIG V

Fifteen-year-old Jaden Rice from the Werribee Districts Football Club and Western Jets will pull on the big V jumper this month after being selected to represent Victoria at the Australian Football Championships.

The Maribyrnong College Sports Academy student was one of only 25 players selected for the Under 15 team in May, these selections being made even tougher with only one Victorian team competing this year.

Playing in the WRFL since he was eight years-old, Rice has shown incredible talent throughout his junior years having played for Yarraville Seddon Eagles and Williamstown Juniors Football Clubs before coming across to the Tigers at the start of the 2015 season.

Representing the WRFL in the AFL Victoria Junior Metro Championships earlier this year, Jaden continues to improve, receiving votes for almost every game he has played this season.

Jaden's father Peter Rice, is incredibly proud of his son's achievements, saying that while only 15-years-old, he has achieved what many players would dream of.

"Jaden's time in football over his journey so far has been really positive.

"My role is to offer support and guidance in any way I can, and the rest I leave up to him."

Rice credited Leon Harris and the coaching staff at Maribyrnong College Sports Academy for playing a fundamental role in Jaden's success.

"The Academy and its program brought Jaden into the AFL program last year and as a family we are very grateful for the opportunities afforded to Jaden by the Sports Academy."

Upon Jaden's selection, his teammates, coaches and officials have been very supportive of his achievement.

"The coaches and players at the WRFL Interleague and the Western Jets have all contributed to this great opportunity," Peter said.

Unlike other years, the 2015 Australian Football Championships will be held in Geelong, allowing for Jaden's extended family and the WRFL community to get down to Kardinia Park between July 18-25 and support him.

Raffle tickets will be sold over the coming weeks at Jaden's local Under 16 games, as well as a fundraiser by the Werribee Districts Football Club

to help raise funds to support the costs associated with playing in the team.

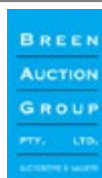

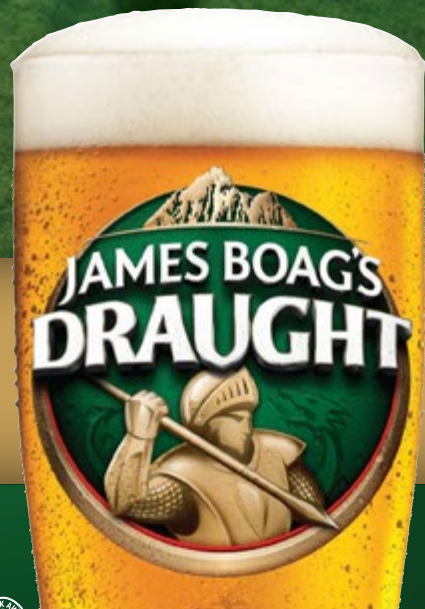

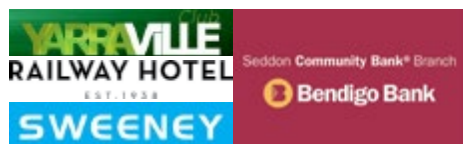

As we entered Round 11, fourth and fifth positions seemed to be the only two spots left up for grabs in the top five, with such a big gap between the top three and the rest of the competition.
