

Loyal players are hard to find in football clubs in today's game. With the lure of money, or the opportunity to play in a premiership seen as incentives to leave a club, it is players such as this, who are a diamond in the rough, and form the backbone to what clubs can be built on. Any milestone is a good one. It's one to be celebrated, whether it be 50, 100, 150, or 200 games, it's a reflection of the journey a player has been on.

For Albanvale's John Sirianni, reaching a milestone like this is not unheard of, having already chalked them up during his illustrious career. However this weekend will be one to savour, as Sirianni will run out for his 400th game of football for the blue and white.

First pulling on the boots with Albanvale at the age of seven, Sirianni has risen through the ranks, having played alongside some great players.

Over the journey, Sirianni has accumulated a host of football accolades, with a Club Best & Fairest both at junior and senior levels, goal kicking awards, been in the WRFL Team of the Year on numerous occasions, and the greatest accolade of all to date, being named as a member in the Cobra's 35th anniversary team.

Though despite all of his individual awards, the quest for a premiership still burns inside his soul. Every pre-season, that's all he thinks about, and

who would blame him.

We all play footy for the ultimate prize and to be crowned champions of the competition alongside your peers. Having just fallen short of that glory last year in their 2-point loss to Braybrook in the Division Three Grand Final, its added motivation for Sirianni and the rest of his teammates to make amends in 2015

And its seems the Cobras have stuck true to their word, sitting first on the ladder, with a stunning 10 wins and all seeming well, look to clinch the club's first ever senior premiership.

The journey that the 29-year-old has been on should be commended, and I'm sure many around the league, either who have played against him, or just watched from over the fence would say no less either. You don't reach this type of milestone unless you love the game, and your football club, something that Albanvale Club Administrator Adam Borg reiterated.

Having played alongside him for a number of years, Borg said that the way Sirianni was playing, he was "not yet" ready to hang up the boots.

INAUGURAL HOTEL 520 SHIELD

The two newest teams to join the WRFL are set to go head to head in today's inaugural Hotel 520 Shield.

The Wyndham Suns, who joined the WRFL this year, will host the second newest team Tarneit, who formed in 2014, in a local derby match set to have the neighbourhood divided.

With both clubs sponsored by Hotel 520, the Shield is a chance for the new clubs to not only earn some silverware and grow its short history, but to create a tradition for years to come.

Coming across from the VAFA to join its junior teams at the start of the year, the Suns have slipped into the Division Three competition seamlessly, showcasing how talented they are with the seniors winning 8 out of their 12 matches.

Club President Graeme Clark said that he was delighted the club was doing so well in its first season in the WRFL.

"(The) Suns have been more competitive than we anticipated this season, which has been fantastic, particularly as a new club in the league," he said.

Situated in one of Melbourne's main growth areas. the transition from the VAFA to the WRFL has been a positive one for the Suns, with Clark stating that the players have enjoyed the "minimal to no travel time," this season.

Through the help of its sponsors, website and new senior coach Matthew Stoodley, the Suns have seen their club and it members expand in size over a relatively short period of time.

With "an average of 100 Tarneit spectators per game," it becomes evident that their support base is continuously being built, with a

fantastic reception from the local community.

"With more people continuously moving into the area, the club continues to grow, along with the help of the club's sponsor Stocklands who advertises the club on their Facebook page," Tarneit Club President Sue Thornton said.

Thornton has been with the club since it originated in December 2013 and has been delighted with the way the club has "improved greatly over the last vear."

With the seniors winning four matches this season, compared to the one match in 2014, the appointment of coach Max DeGroot has had a very positive impact on the side.

In the pair's first clash in Round 6 earlier this year resulting in a draw, there will be no shortage of rivalry, as the newest local derby will be sure to draw a huge following.

While it is the first Shield of its kind, Clark hopes for "two 520 Shields to be held in the 2016 season, with the four sponsored Hotel 520 clubs getting involved in the future."

Sunshine has knocked Werribee Districts off the top of the ladder and now sits just a game out of second place after its 15-point win over the Tigers.

UMPIRES CORNER

By Graeme Hodgart

Recently the WRFL field umpires had a meeting at Scovell Reserve which was facilitated by Director of Umpiring Mark Westgarth. It was basically a brief review of the first half of the season. The emphasis was on the three umpiring system which has been much more evident early this season as well as getting feedback on what has been working well this year.

Different ideas were aired, with quite a few umpires given the chance to put forward their opinions and justify their thinking. The opportunity to be involved in the three umpiring system on a regular basis and not have to wait until closer to the finals was clearly seen as a big positive. One goal umpire, Craig Hill, mentioned that having the three field umpires meant that very few of the obvious free kicks were being missed. Umpires were now well-positioned to see any of the off-the-ball holding infringements.

The rotation of the field umpires through the three divisions was also seen as a very good move as it gave the top umpires a mental break from the Division One games. It also gave more umpires the experience of Division One football and allowed the younger and/or inexperienced umpires to run and learn from others.

Additional areas of strength also mentioned were the retention of play after short kicks and finding the correct position and distance from contested ball situations. Also backing out from ball-up contests quickly and correctly and maintaining proper set kick control were also seen as improved aspects of general field umpiring in 2015.

Discussion also centred on the positioning of the end zone field umpire and the mid zone umpire. It was felt that sometimes these umpires were not positioning themselves in the correct position. This meant that at times they were slightly caught out when the next act of play happened.

While there has been a really positive start to the umpiring division this season, we must take what we have learnt from the start of the year and strive to improve once again, as we creep closer to what will be a very exciting 2015 finals series.



LAWS OF THE GAME – QUIZ #13 Last week's question:

Player A takes a mark just before the behind scoring line, plays on immediately and stumbles forward with the football tucked under his right arm. His left shoulder and left arm makes heavy contact with the padding on the goal post before he kicks the ball through for a goal. What happens next?

The correct answer was (OPTION A) The field umpire, after awarding the mark, would call Play On and then give the goal umpire the All Clear and a goal would be registered.

This week's question:

Player A has marked the ball deep in the forward pocket close to the boundary. The siren sounds and the field umpire lines the player up for his shot on goal. The player takes three or four steps to his right and kicks a goal. What happens next?

- (a) The field umpire runs in and lines the player up for another kick but tells him to not go off his line this time.
- (b) The field umpire signals All Clear to the goal umpire and a goal is registered.
- (c) The field umpire signals end of play and informs the goal umpire that there is no score.
