





FOOTY PROVIDES US WITH SOME AMAZING HIGHLIGHTS FROM TIME TO TIME.

The thrill of waking up on a Saturday and watching your team play, seeing players embrace the contest, take those high flying marks, dribble goals along the ground or it could just be that one player that we all love watch burst through packs with ease.

Then there is the downside to the game, one of which is injury.

Albanvale player Blake Charlton knows all too well how cruel injuries can be after suffering this fate in Round 5 during his match against Laverton.

Only minutes into the first quarter, Charlton collided with another player in the centre of the field and broke his lower leg in two places.

Taken off the ground in an ambulance, the game was called off and Charlton has since been on the road to recovery, slowly taking tentative steps to not only return to the footy field, but back to his everyday life.

Working as a carpenter, the injury has hampered his day to day life, with many underestimating the severity of the injury and the struggle that he would experience.

Two months since his accident, the Laverton Football Club had Blake Charlton on their mind when the two clubs met in their next encounter in Round 12.

"After the game, in their rooms, they (Laverton FC) had their coach speak for a bit, and they did a couple of raffles on the side to help raise some money for Blake while he was out of work with his injury," Albanvale Club Administrator Adam Borg said.

"On behalf of the Albanvale Football Club, we want people out there to know that we want to thank the Laverton Magpies for their generous effort and support."

Through the support of not only his own team over the past eight weeks, but that of the Laverton Magpies, Charlton has returned to the club and is on the mend

"He is in good spirits and is up and walking now which has been great to see, as well as attending a number of our games," Borg said.

During their Round 12 clash a fortnight ago, the funds raised from the raffle has been a great help to Charlton as he continues to recover from his injury and gets back on his feet at work.

Its gestures like these that goes to show that while we are rivals on the football field, we are one unit off the field and are willing to band together when accidents like this arise.

I'm sure I speak on behalf of the wider football community and would like to wish Blake a successful recovery and hope to see him back in the blue and white next year for the Cobras.

Congratulations also goes to the Laverton Football Club for doing their part in supporting others in the football community.

MANOR LAKES BOUNCE BACK

The Manor Lakes Football Club is working hard to bounce back stronger than ever after falling victim to seven separate break-ins over the past nine months.

With the last two robberies occurring only days apart from one another last month, the club has been left with an estimated loss of more than \$30,000.

Appearing on 3AW's Drive Home radio program in the days after the incident, Club President Troy Whiting said that the support from the community has been really positive.

"Earlier this year we held a number of fundraisers for people in our community with the Lake Gladman tragedy as well as a Breast Cancer Awareness Day, so it's been nice to have the local community support us back."

Whiting said that some of the items stolen in the robberies were "game day apparel, alcohol from the bar, and much needed medical equipment," including "tape, strapping, our defibrillator and TENS-unit."

The clubrooms, which is also shared with the Manor Lakes Cricket Club in the off-season, is located in an open area with its only means of protection being an internal alarm.

While the Wyndham Council installed an antitheft plate on the doors after the first break-in during October last year, Whiting said that the

preventative measure was not as effective as first thought.

"It's just not stopping them as they are actually bending the anti-theft plates using a crowbar.

"I've also requested we get roller shutters on all of the doors, I've sent messages to the council numerous times asking for our alarm system to be upgrade and am yet to hear of a solution."

Until then the only other preventative measure that is being undertaken is simply ensuring the "club is properly locked and is undergoing regular checks," with alcohol no longer left on the premises.

The financial damage is obvious but it is the affect that these break-ins is having on the rest of the club, especially the players that is of concern.

"These players have no equipment which has made training sessions very difficult," Whiting said.

"Even things such as the game day footballs and compression bandages were stolen."

Hearing of the Storm's recent robbery, neighbourhood clubs Wyndham Suns and Glen Orden have helped the club get back on its feet by donating footballs, tape and even lending their spare defibrillator.

Since Whiting's 3AW report, the broader football community has also shown great generosity with Western Bulldogs Vice President Susan Alberti offering to donate a new defibrillator once the club's security has been upgraded.

"I think it is absolutely vitally important that they have a defibrillator at the club as I know it saves lives and I've seen them save lives, so I'm very happy to do that," Alberti told 3AW.





UMPIRES CORNER

For the last three years the WRFL umpires have been using a computer program called Schedula to issue their weekly appointments. It is a very effective tool which has worked efficiently with most umpiring groups now using the program.

Early each week, the umpires' coaching staff log into Schedula and appoint their allotted umpires to officiate at the different games. At 12 noon each Wednesday, all umpires who have been appointed to at least one game receive a general email telling them of this fact. Individual umpires then log onto the system and find out the details about their game. This includes the day, date, time, the teams involved, the location of the ground and their fellow umpires on their panel. It even provides directions on how to get to the various grounds.

Every umpire then has the opportunity to confirm or decline their appointment. The majority usually accept their games but occasionally umpires are unable to officiate for various reasons. If they decline their appointment they must explain why. Every time an umpire declines a game, an email is automatically sent to the coach who then has the opportunity to make any necessary changes.

Another advantage of Schedula is that it keeps accurate records of all the games that umpires officiate in. There are only a few current umpires that have kept an accurate tally of their games throughout their career. This group includes Terry McGarity, Michael Lynch and Trevor Budge. In the future, Schedula will be able to be used to calculate when umpires are approaching a milestone match.

Prior to Schedula, the appointments were handed out on sheet s of paper but those who were unable to attend the Wednesday training/meeting didn't know what game they were appointed to. This meant that the coaching staff had to make numerous phone calls or send out emails to inform umpires about their games.

The present system keeps each umpire informed and does save a great deal of time and energy especially for those who are appointing the umpires to games. As the years roll on, the system will be further refined and extended to include other features. For those umpires who began umpiring in 2013 or in the years that follow, their

entire umpiring career can be reviewed by just pressing one button in Schedula. How good is that? For more information, visit our website www. wrflumpires.com
