Having supported sons Michael, Corey and Jesse through their football careers over the past 15 years, father Darren will come out of retirement to play the last game of the home and away season against Manor Lakes.

Despite already having father-son duos play in the same team before, this will be the first time a father will play with all three of his sons at the Glen Orden Football Club

With the passion for the game and the love of the Hawks passed down to his children, Darren said that today's match was something he had never thought possible.

"It's a dream come true and something that I never thought we would have the opportunity to do," he said.

"I've played with the boys individually before on the odd occasion, but never all four of us together, so it should be a really proud moment for me as a father."

Joining Glen Orden in 1999, Darren has not only been a successful player at the club, but has also coached at both junior and seniors levels, recently pulling on the whistle this year to lead the Reserves.

With oldest son Michael returning to football after ten seasons to captain the reserves team this year and both Corey and Jesse playing in the seniors squad, Darren said that the club was happy to accommodate to make his dream a reality.

"We've always talked about it, but it's only really come together in the last couple of weeks," he said.

"The club comes first, and obviously with us not making finals this season, the club gave us permission for me to come out of retirement and play with my boys.

"Particularly with their willingness to allow Jesse and Corey to come down from the seniors to play in the Reserves team has been great."

Yet despite their competitiveness on the field, Darren said that there won't be any family rivalry in the game, with all four men just happy to be a part of it.

"While I'm sure the boys will want to put in a good performance, we're all just happy to be there, win, lose or draw."

But just when you thought there were enough Edwards men at the game this weekend, Darren's father will also be in attendance, supporting his grandsons from the sidelines.

"The old man will be there watching on as well as a number of other family and friends, so it should be a great day and hopefully we come away with a win."



ROUND WRAP DIVISION ONE RESERVES



Hoppers Crossing has solidified its tag as premiership favourites after an easy win over neighbourhood rivals, Werribee Districts.

A close result had been expected going into the match, as the Warriors and Districts sat first and second on the ladder respectively.

Yet the final score was anything but a tight affair, as ladder leading Hoppers Crossing sent a warning to the rest of the competition, with a comfortably 14.7(91) to 4.6(30) victory.

Despite the Warriors leading by three goals at quarter time, the game was far from over, with the visitors biting back to bridge the gap to just one goal at halftime.

However the Tigers run of good form ended as Hoppers Crossing came out after the major break to dominate all over the ground, holding Werribee goalless and piling on nine majors of its own.

The 61-point win cements the Warriors in first place heading into its round 18 clash against Deer Park, while the Districts will look to maintain second place when they host Spotswood.

At JL Murphy Reserve, four goals in the third quarter was enough to see Deer Park across the line against Port Melbourne, in a game that could have gone either way at halftime.

However a third quarter fadeout again doomed the Colts, who had kept pace with the Lions for the opening half.

The 11.11(77) to 7.11(53) victory was a good bounce back win for Deer Park, after being on the end of a 78-point loss in round 16.

UMPIRES CORNER

Recently an invitation went out from the AFL Umpiring Department for local community umpires' coaches to attend one of their training nights. The location was IKON Park where the AFL umpires have their training facilities. Three WRFL umpiring coaches took advantage and accepted the invitation to attend.

Group training for the AFL umpires takes place two nights a week for about two hours although every umpire on the list would have a set routine that they follow each day in order to maintain a very high standard of fitness. The session include work in the extensive gym, meetings and video reviews.

Umpire boss, Hayden Kennedy, believes in a skill-based training program and so a fair amount of time for the field umpires revolves around honing their skills. This includes position-making, bouncing the football and trigger running to name a few. The training for the boundary umpires tends to be focussed on running, running and running and of course tossing the ball into play, which is an important part of their training program.

The goal umpires do some running and then work mostly on skills to do with positioning and decision-making. On this particular night, the goalies had a two kilometre time trial on the running track outside the ground. Most completed the run between seven and a half and eight and a half minutes. After a short recovery, which was a walk or jog back into the ground, two goalies introduced an activity each which occupied the next 30 minutes. Using the goals, the first activity was basically the goal umpire adjudging the score from a low twenty metre kick into goal with a defender coming in at right angles. The second activity had the goal umpire deciding on the score from a 30 metre kick that was dropping on the line with a defender coming from behind the goalie.

It was interesting to see how the goal umpires dealt with the different scenarios, and immediately acknowledged any errors in judgement which may have occurred. Afterwards there was a short video session to view good and not so good goal umpiring positioning from the previous week's games.

Within the goal umpiring group there was an obvious heavy influence of WRFL expertise. Both coaches, Rod Davies and Steve Sterling, were from our region before having long careers as AFL goal umpires. Also, within the 12 goal umpires at training, two of them in David Dixon and Michael Craig, umpired in the WRFL before progressing to a higher level.

Hopefully it won't be too far into the future that more western suburban umpires are able to take the next step and make it onto a VFL list. After that, it's all a matter of time, persistence, effort, commitment, dedication, ability and performance that sees the select few be promoted to the AFL level.

ROUND WRAP DIVISION TWO UNDER 18


