MANOR LAKES RALLIES FOR THREE ANGELS

It was a regular Wednesday afternoon for the Guode family who were travelling along Manor Lakes Boulevard on what was supposed to be a normal day.

Yet little did they know their lives would be turned upside down forever when tragedy struck, with three young lives lost and another left fighting for life.

One-year-old baby boy Bol and four-year-old Anger and her twin brother Madit lost their lives after their mother's car ran off the road and plunged into Lake Gladman late last week.

Rocking the Wyndham community, the Manor Lakes Football Club has rallied together to hold a special fundraising event on Sunday April 19 to raise money and show its support for the Guode family.

Having played in a special tribute match against neighbourhood club Wyndhamvale last Saturday night, Manor Lakes President Troy Whiting said that the club was keen to help the local family.

"Although the family weren't directly involved in the club, the Manor Lakes community has been deeply rocked by the tragedy, with many of our junior players attending the same school as the children did.

"We are such a close knit community so everyone has been saddened by the tragedy and are keen to help out where possible."

Kicking off at Howqua Road Reserve from 3pm-6pm, the event will have a host of activities for the family to enjoy including a jumping castle, pony rides, face painting, amusement rides, a dog wash and a range of food and beverages.

A minute silence will also take place before 7pm and balloons will be released, followed by lighting of candles in memory of the three angels taken too soon.

"All funds from the day will be given directly to the Guode family to assist with the financial strain they may encounter," Whiting said.

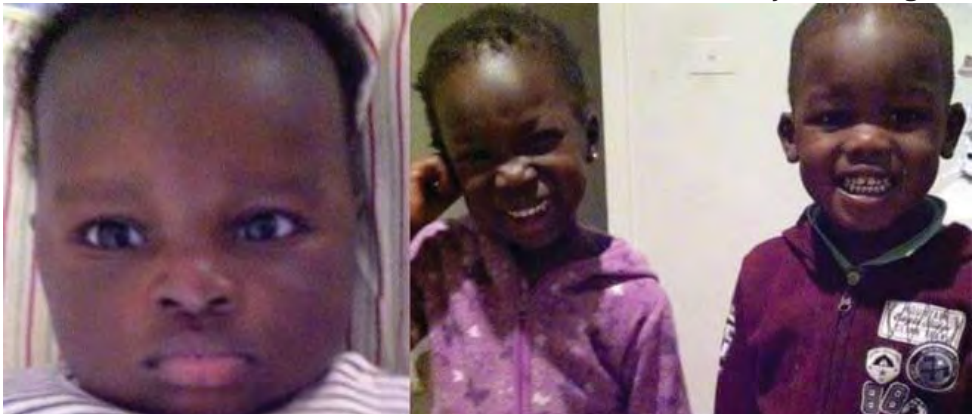
"The whole sporting community, along with local businesses and the people of Wyndham are urging everyone to come along and donate and to show your support for a very heart torn family."

Whiting said that if the support shown at last Saturday's tribute match was anything to go by, then the turnout from the local community on Sunday should be promising.

"Obviously last Saturday's night match was very emotional for all, but it just shows that two competing teams can put their on-field rivalries aside and pay their respects to three young children from our community who were taken far too soon."

SUNS OFF TO A SCORCHER

While many people have noticed the new Wyndham Suns uniform running around in the Division Three competition, some of you may not be aware about the club and its new

changes happening in 2015.

Having played only junior games at its home ground of Goddard Street last year, the Suns are excited to introduce its senior teams in the WRFL Division Three competition in 2015 after coming across from the Victorian Amateurs Football Association to rejoin their junior counterparts.

Officially rebranding itself at the Wyndham Suns at the end of 2013, the club has already won its first premierships flag, with its Under 14B side taking home the silverware last season.

Fast forward six months and the Suns will field nine teams in 2015, ranging from its Under 9s to its seniors.

Having worked from portable change rooms last year and with the expansion of its teams, the Suns are proud to establish a fresh club house at Goddard Street on Saturday April 18, with the official opening to coincide with its first home game against Braybrook.

In addition to the club house, the shift in leagues has seen some major changes on the field, with the appointment of three new coaches.

Matthew Stoodley (senior coach), John Cott (reserves coach) and Michael Seex (reserve assistant coach) along with assistant coach Joe Pace have been praised for their professionalism and high standards in developing the Suns' new senior sides.

The dedication and determination is evident, not just seen by the coaching staff, but also the players, having started training prior to the pre-season.

Securing its major sponsor in Westbrook Estate

this year, it seems the Suns are off to a scorcher, with two wins for its senior and reserve teams in the opening round last week.

Coming off their 17-point win over Sanctuary Lakes, the seniors will play its first game at Goddard Street against reigning premiers Braybrook who currently sit fifth on the ladder, two behind Wyndham Suns. The Reserves will also want to keep its winning streak alive today after defeating the Sharks 12.11-83 to 7.9-51.

If what we saw in week one is anything to go by, the Wyndham Suns look likely to be a strong and challenging side in the new Division Three tier. However despite what it says the scoreboard, one thing is certain, that 2015 is set to be a big and exciting year for the Wyndham Suns.

DIVISION ONE RESERVES

Deer Park has kicked off its 2015 campaign in style with a convincing 68-point victory over Spotswood.

The Lions gave their home crowd a first round treat as they led from the front, extending the margin at each break before running home 17.14.116 to 7.6.48 winners.

Despite the loss, Spotswood will look to bounce back at home in Round 2 as they come up against last year's premiers St. Albans, while Deer Park will travel away to face Altona.

The Vikings will be keen to seek its first win of their season in the second round clash after going down to Werribee Districts.

Fans were on the edge of their seats as scores were tied up at three quarter-time, before a five goal to three final term pushed the Tigers over the line 16.56.102 to 14.6.90.

Altona's Matthew Davies tried his hand at playing match winner for the visitors as he booted a game-high six goals, however a combined 10-goal haul from Aaron and Andrew Taylor helped seal the win for the home team.

The Tigers will have an extra week to prepare for its next clash against Sunshine in Round 3, with the bye scheduled for today.

At JL Murphy Reserve, Albion ran out 30-point victors over the Port Melbourne Colts, after five unanswered goals in the third term made the difference for the Cats.

The 9.16.70 to 5.10.40 win places the Cats at second on the ladder after one round, while the Colts are sitting just outside the top four at sixth.

Albion will play its first home game in Round 2, matching up against Sunshine who had the bye in the opening round, while the Colts will travel to Hogans Road to face Hoppers Crossing.

The Warriors will be keen to continue its Round 1 form this week after three goals to Kyle Traynor and Cameron Wilson helped Hoppers Crossing to a 28-point win over St. Albans in the annual Good Friday clash.

The first and third terms were critical to the Warriors win, outscoring the Saints by 49-points. A four goal to two final quarter helped bring the score closer, yet the damage had already been inflicted.

LAWS OF THE GAME – QUIZ #1

Last week's question:

A player from Team A dives on top off the football and is grabbed correctly by an opposition player. The player in possession of the ball immediately punches the ball away. What happens next? The correct answer was **OPTION A** – The field umpire calls, "Play on." The player who dived on top of the ball cannot be penalised because he has disposed of the ball correctly immediately after being grabbed. The tackler cannot be penalised because he tackled the player who was in possession correctly.

This week's question:

A player from the attacking team picks up the ball and kicks towards goal. The ball, which was heading straight towards the goal post, touches the goal umpire's leg inside the field of play before crossing the goal line. What happens next?

- The field umpire blows the whistle, cancels the score and then bounces the ball on the edge of the goal square.
- The field umpire calls, "All clear" and the goal umpire signals a goal by raising both index fingers and raising two flags.
- The field umpire calls, "All clear" and the goal umpire signals one behind by tapping his/her chest three times, raising one index finger and hitting the post three times before waving one flag.

DIVISION TWO UNDER 18

The teams may look different with a new group of players moving into the Under 18 competition, but both Grand Finalists from 2014 have begun this season with strong wins.

Sunshine put a shock through the Newport camp in the opening half, leading by 12-points at the main break before the Power took back momentum, kicking nine goals to three in the second half, to run out 12.8.80 to 8.3.51 winners.

Mitchell Taleb kicked five for the visitors and Bashir Zahraman added three. Nicholas Millar kicked three for the Roos, while Matthew Chatterton and Luke Frahm were among the best for Sunshine.

The two other games from round one saw Hoppers Crossing romp home against Glen Orden by 121-points and Wyndamvale began its 2015 campaign in style with a comfortable 63-point win over Caroline Springs.

Round 2 will see Werribee Districts come up against a competitive Sunshine outfit and Hoppers Crossing will play hosts to Wyndamvale. Sanctuary Lakes

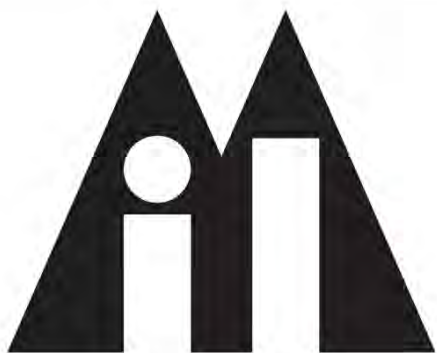

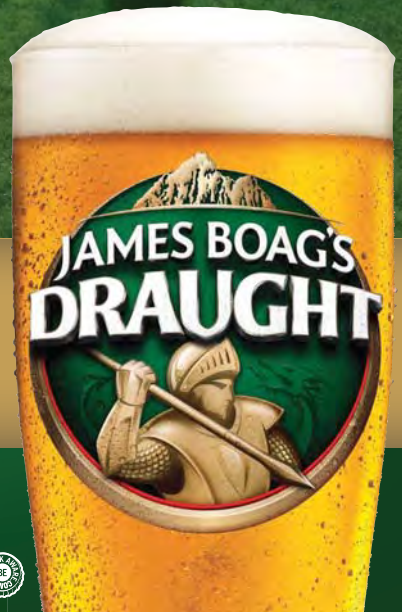
