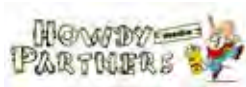

ROUND WRAP

DIVISION ONE RESERVES

Hoppers Crossing has well and truly stamped its authority on the Division One Reserves competition, keeping its unblemished record intact after another big win last week, this time over Albion.

The ladder-leading Warriors were simply too strong in both their attack and defence, limiting the Cats to just four goals for the match.

The home team extended the margin at each break, finishing as 103-point victors, thanks in part to a six goal haul from Warrior Kyle Traynor.

Despite being held scoreless in the final term, Albion will look to bounce back bigger and better this week at home when they face Werribee Districts, while Hoppers Crossing will take on Spotswood in search of its fourth win.

Around the grounds, Port Melbourne Colts chalked up its first win of the season, narrowly defeating Spotswood by two points.

The 10.10.70 to 9.14.68 victory was sealed with a two goal to one final term, with Spotswood unable to capitalise on a one-point three quarter time lead.

The Colts will aim to make it two wins in a row when they face home side Altona, who will be looking to get back on the winners list after a 28-point loss to St.Albans.

A four goal to one opening term was key for the Saints who led at every break, as Anthony Fawcus and James Romeo each kicked two goals for the home side.

The Saints will enjoy the round 4 bye today after the 9.8.62 to 5.4.34 victory solidified its place into the top four, behind Werribee Districts who sits in third after a win over Sunshine.

Showing no hangover from their Round 2 bye, the Tigers held Sunshine to a season-low score, running out 11.19.85 to 1.8.14 winners.

With just the one goal kicked against them, the Tigers’ forward line pressure from Aaron Taylor, Zachary Mcmillan and Matthew Palmington saw them kick two goals each in the last to lead Werribee to the 71-point victory.

Sunshine will host Deer Park today, who is coming

We spoke to his Mum & Dad about playing seniors and promised to look after him deep forward all day. He ended up playing senior football from Round One and then in turn invited down to the Western Jets. Still say G'Day to his Mum & Dad and keep in touch with Josh. He is currently going really well with Williamstown FC. Loves his footy and was a pleasure watching him progress, albeit for only one season.

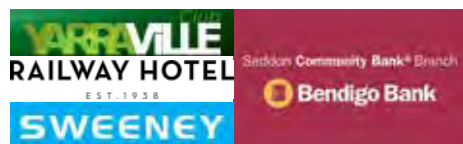

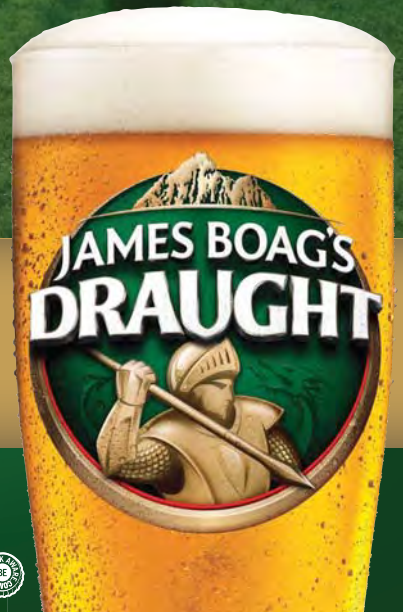
