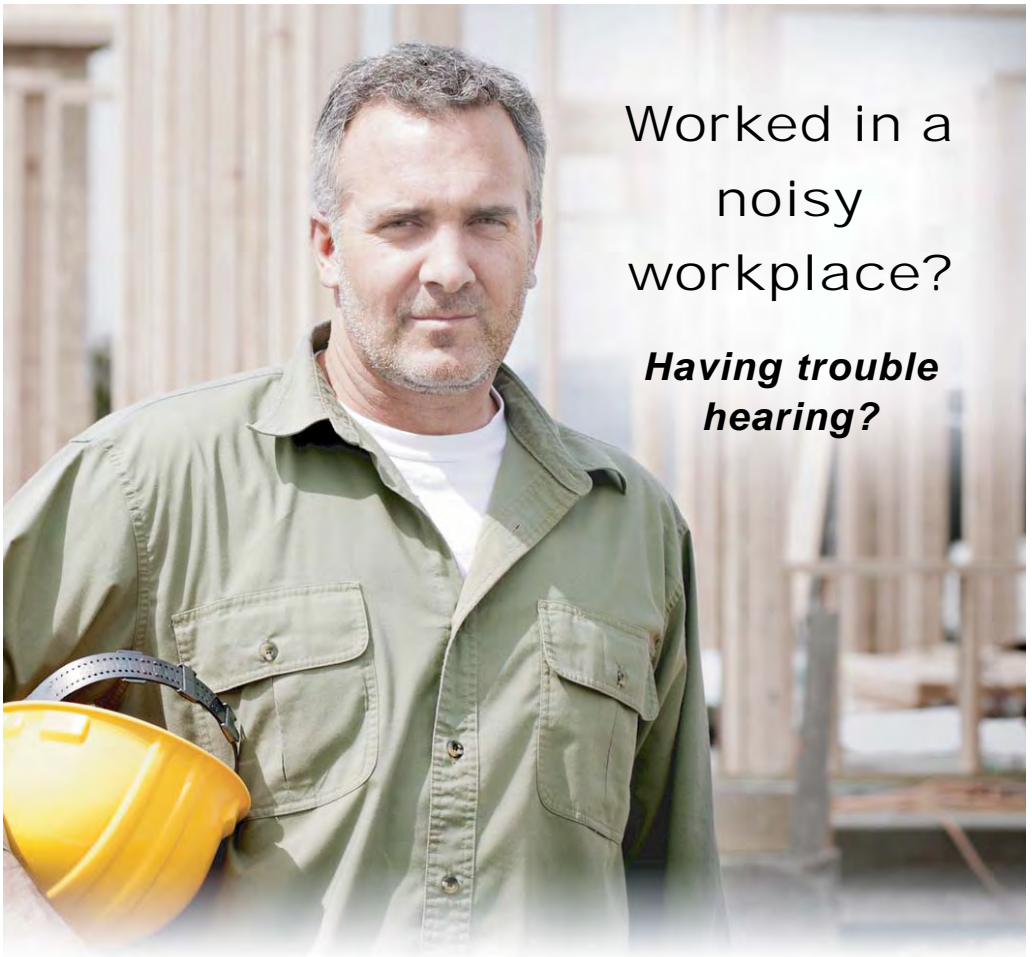

WOMEN PROVE THEY'E GOT WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A TOP UMP

Female umpiring ranks in the Western Region Football League continue to grow, with one former boundary umpire taking big strides toward her dream of reaching the top.

Shannessy Adams, 30, made history last weekend when she officiated as part of the first ever all-female umpiring panel in AFL Victoria's TAC Cup competition.

But it is the female numbers at local level that are most pleasing for WRFL head of umpiring Mark Westgarth, with an influx of new umpires entering the competition in 2015.

"We've probably got three or four goal, 10 or 11 boundary and half a dozen field (female) umpires new to this season," Westgarth said.

"It's growing, no doubt, through our academies. They all start at under-9s and under-10s and move up."

MacKillop College, where Westgarth works as a teacher, started the first umpiring academy in 2009 with backing from AFL Victoria.

Since then, the WRFL has introduced similar programs at Westbourne Grammar and Caroline Springs College.

"It's all about the skills and we teach boundary, field and goal umpiring," he said.

"It runs from 4pm to 5.15pm, straight after school. A lot of coaching goes into it.

"But we've got three or four guys umpiring in Division 1 that started in schools' academies, and it's taken them four or five years."

Westgarth said Adams' success was a testament to the program run at the WRFL.

"She works really, really hard in terms of running, but all credit goes to Lee Rowbottom, our boundary coach," he said.

"She matches it with most of the boys, and she's got a really good chance of going much further. The AFL is keen to fast-track that."

Adams is part of the VFL development squad, which allows her to umpire in TAC Cup and VFL reserves.

"At the moment she's in the development squad, but if she performs she can move into the VFL (seniors) area," he said.

"We put five up for trial, three boundary umpires, one field and one goal, and they all made it."

Westgarth said the league would love to have its own all-female umpiring panel in a senior match, but that was still some time away.

"No doubt we would do that, but you've got to have the quality there," he said.

"There's no reason why we couldn't go close in an under-16s match. It takes time to develop these kids, we don't want to burn them."

With the AFL officially establishing the round in 2014, football leagues across the country will celebrate and recognize the contribution thousands of umpires make every weekend to our great game.

In celebration of Community Umpiring Round, WRFL umpires had a great opportunity during the week to be coached by some of the AFL's best boundary, goal and field umpires.

Five AFL umpires came down to the WRFL umpires training night on Wednesday at Scovell Reserve, to teach the young umpires a few strategies and skills as a means to further educated these aspiring umpires.

AFL field umpires Nick Foot and Brent Wallace, boundary umpires Marantelli and Matthew Tomkins and goal umpire Steven Piperno also stayed after training for a Q&A session where the WRFL umpires were encouraged to ask any pressing questions.

WRFL Director of Umpiring Mark Westgarth said that it was a real honour to have a group of AFL umpires come down to training and give back to grassroots football.

"It gives the WRFL umpires a chance to ask these professionals questions regarding umpiring that they may never have had answered.

"It's definitely a great opportunity for the young kids to see what it takes to become an umpire."

It is evident that these young umpires are determined to become the best umpires possible, training three nights a week as well as adjudicating matches on the weekend.

With just under 300 men and women adjudicating across the league, these young umpires have shown great dedication towards becoming the best possible umpires.

Along with the five AFL umpires coming to the WRFL training session, in celebration of the Community Umpiring Round, five other WRFL umpires were picked to attend an education and training session on Tuesday May 12.

Hosted by AFL umpire coaches at IKON Park, the WRFL's Tom Harrison, Dean McGowan, Sean Weise, Jordan Wiltshire and Jarrod Walson learnt from some of the best in the business which will no doubt assist with their development and furthering their umpiring career.

Community Umpiring Round is a great opportunity for not only these umpires to learn and to develop new skills by professional AFL umpires, but it also recognizes all our umpires and allows the rest of the football community to show our appreciation for the great work they do.

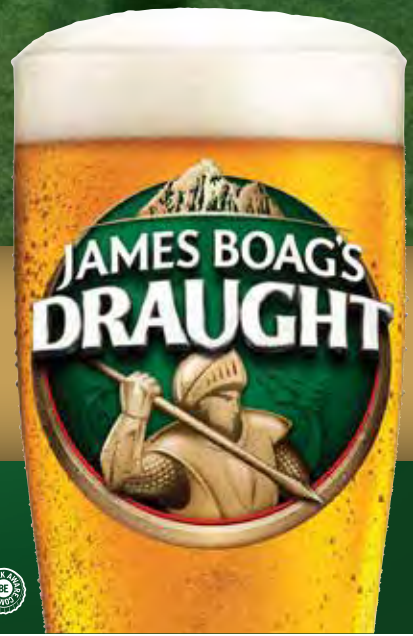

ROUND WRAP

DIVISION ONE RESERVES



Altona has pulled off the upset of the season after defeating a previously unbeaten Hoppers Crossing side by 22-points.

The 10.9(69) to 7.5(47) win was spurred on by a four goal third quarter, as the visitors led at each break.

Defence was imperative for the Vikings in the win, as they held the Warriors to just one goal in both the first and fourth quarters. Altona's Brett Miller kicked a game-high three goals, while teammates Shaun Collis and Nathan Wapshott added two each.

The round six bye will help the Warriors regroup after their first loss of the season, while Altona will look for their third straight victory today, hosting Spotswood.

In a rematch of last season's grand final, Sunshine has come from behind to defeat reigning premiers St. Albans. Despite trailing by nine-points at the final break, Sunshine rallied to kick five goals to one, running out 8.13(61) to 6.9(45) winners.

After taking the lead in the third quarter, the loss will sting for the Saints, who are now sitting just inside the top four on percentage.

St. Albans will look to get back onto the winners list as they face Werribee Districts at Soldiers Reserve today, with Sunshine coming up against a Port Melbourne Colts side fresh off the bye.

Spotswood has earned its first win of the season, downing Albion by 31-points. A seven goal to zero second quarter ended the contest, as the Cats only managed to kick seven goals for the match.

The 13.7(85) to 7.12(54) win lifts the Woodsmen off the bottom of the ladder, and pushes Albion to last place after its fourth consecutive loss.

Albion will look to end its losing streak away from home when they come up against a Deer Park outfit keen to stay in the top four, after suffering its first loss at the hands of Werribee Districts.

The Tigers edged out Deer Park in a low scoring game, eventually running out 6.8(44) to 3.11(29) victors.

Wayward kicking doomed the Lions as its inefficiency in attack allowed Werribee Districts to win the scrappy affair.

Neither side kicked a goal in the first quarter, however a four goal second term from the visitors

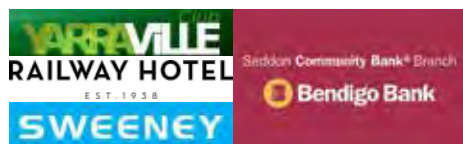

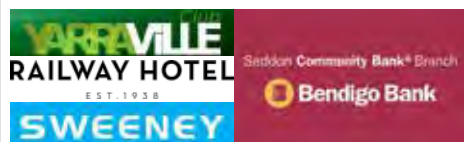
