# KICKIN' IT WITH BOB

## SEASON 2016 IS HERE, BRING IT ON

**WELCOME to the 2016 WRFL football season. With Round 1 to kick things off this weekend, hope springs eternal with all teams hungry for on-field success and all on equal ladder positions. This weekend's games will certainly put paid to that state of affairs!**

Interest in senior football will be heightened this year with the introduction of the state-wide Player Points System (PPS). Aimed to improve competitive balance and moderate the cost burden of player payments, the PPS will limit the number of 'non-home-grown' players that can be fielded in any first 18 team on any day. The PPS rewards clubs for developing and retaining their own players; and penalised with additional points players who move from club to club. Along with club salary caps planned for introduction next year, the PPS is planned to assist volunteer club officials in containing costs and evening-out competitive balance. While the initial work of allocating and verifying each players points allocation has been onerous for both club officials and WRFL operations staff, it is expected that those efforts will be rewarded over time.

The ranks of junior WRFL football continue to grow, with the increase in age-grades from Under 16 to Under 17 as the apex of Sunday competition; and expansion for girls' football to Under 12, 15 and 18 competitions this season. Although touted as the fastest-growing

sector of the game, female football has been slow to gain traction across our region. It is hoped that the integration of girls' football into the regular Sunday junior program will showcase the opportunities for girls to participate and spark a significant increase in interest.

In response to demand for an earlier transition from NAB Auskick to club football, a modified Under 8s program will also be on offer this year. Overall, it is expected that team numbers will increase by around 15 teams compared to last season.

The change from Under 18 to Under 19 competition will see a temporary reduction in team numbers this year, as there will be little or no flow-through from Sunday junior ranks with the new Under 17 grade now on offer. It is critical for the future that we retain as many Under 19 teams as possible this year in order to maintain the base for expansion from 2017 onwards.

The standing of WRFL football has been enhanced significantly with former AFL identities Mark Williams, Brendan Fevola, Brian Lake and Paul Chapman, amongst others, joining our clubs this year. Their vote of confidence in our league is greatly appreciated and we look forward to their positive influences on both playing standards and club cultures.

Best wishes to all players, supporters and particularly to the army of hard working volunteer club officials who make our game possible. Whatever your measure of success, we hope you find the 2016 season an enjoyable experience.

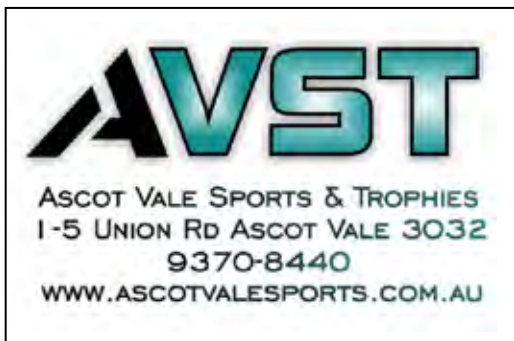

## COMPETITION FOR SPOTS TO BE FIERCE

**WESTERN Region Football League coach Anthony Eames is on the verge of announcing a squad for the 2016 WorkSafe AFL Victoria Community Championships.**

With just six weeks before the match, Eames, chairman of selectors Steve Thom and assistant coach Brett Jacobs have been busy keeping their eyes across the competition.

The trio have been attending practice matches over the past few weeks and are on the cusp of announcing a squad of players who they think will wear the WRFL jumper with pride.

"There has been some interesting discussions over the last two months, we are really starting to get excited about the game now," Eames said.

"We have put a squad of 50 together, but the good thing about the squad is that players you don't know a lot about pop up and surprise you.

"Once the season starts there will also be other players that could have form that jump up for selection, so we will also add to that squad."

Eames said he was looking forward to getting the training sessions underway.

He said there was a lot of quality talent in the WRFL and competition for spots would be fierce.

"There will be a lot of competition for spots, but that's what we want to see," Eames said.

"Together with Brett (Jacobs) we have planned some exciting things for the group."

On the Ballarat front, the league appointed Shaun O'Loughlin coach of the senior team.

O'Loughlin takes over from Shane Skontra, who led Ballarat to victory over Bendigo in last year's WorkSafe AFL Victoria Championship match.

He is a Level 3 AFL Accredited coach who spent five years as a Development Coach and Senior Coach in the Ballarat FNC.

Eames said his aim in the short term was picking the best WRFL team possible, he says he hasn't focussed on what Ballarat was doing just yet.

"My focus is on what is available to us and selecting the players that will suit the ground we are playing," he said.

"Once we get closer to finalising the squad we will look at Ballarat, but I have a good idea of who the key performers are for Ballarat."

Some of the WRFL's rising stars will also get a chance to test their skills against Ballarat, with an Under-19 match scheduled as a curtain raiser to the senior game.

Spotswood premierships coach Matt Dean was appointed coach.

He led the Woodsman to consecutive Under-18 flags over the past two seasons.

Dean said he was looking forward to working with the league's most exciting young talent.

"It is a great chance for me to work with some of the players I have admired over the past couple of years," he said.

"I am very competitive and so are the boys helping me, so we do want to win and we want to give the boys every chance possible to win."

Dean will be joined by assistants, WRFL veteran Gary Turner, Hoppers Crossing Under-19 coach Alan Williams and Yarraville Seddon's Under-19 coach Greg Wray.

The Interleague match between the WRFL and the Red Onion Ballarat Football Netball League will be played on Saturday, May 21 at Whitten Oval.

The Under-19 match will be played at 11.45am and the Senior match will kick-off at 2.30pm.

# TIV PARTNERSHIP KICKING GOALS



The strong partnership between the WRFL and TIV is set to continue in 2016.

The two organisations have worked together for several years and will continue to work hand-in-hand to promote TIV's building and training programs for another year.

In 2016, TIV will take on the naming rights of the Leagues Under-19 competition, which will now be known as the TIV Cup.

Participants in the new Under-19 competition are the target audience for TIV's Cert 3 in Carpentry and Bricklaying courses.

TIV's Business Development manager Jason Pickles said club's showed a great interest in the TIV course at the league's Suppliers and Partners function earlier this year.

"A number of WRFL clubs expressed an interest in me visiting their clubs to talk to their Under-19 players, and their parents, about the opportunities this Cert 3 in Carpentry and Bricklaying courses offered," he said.

Mr Pickles went on to say that a number of AFL footballers have enrolled in these courses, with the support of their club, in a bid to be better prepared for life after football.

"We're very pleased to have TIV sign up again as a partner," WRFL's Peter Harley said.

"TIV's involvement provides our clubs with the opportunity to pass on to their Under-19 players and their family's information about potential careers in the building industry."

Mr Pickles will be in contact with WRFL clubs to set up times for an initial visit as well as to discuss the option of TIV's presenting to the Under 19 players and their parents.

## NEWPORT POWER READY FOR SENIOR DEBUT

**AFTER hours on the track, in the gym and behind the scenes, Newport Power is ready to launch into the 2016 season.**

The Power is embarking on its first season in the senior competition, after 10 years of solely being a junior Western Region Football League club.

The club enters the Division 3 competition and today all their work and preparation will be put to the test when they compete in its first senior game against Tarneit.

At the helm as playing-coach for their inaugural season is former Hawthorn premiership hero Mark Williams, who was unveiled by the club last year.

Williams said he was looking forward to playing in his first game.

"I am keen to see if the hard work we have put in over pre-season will pay off with some strong competitive efforts and maybe even a few wins," he said.

The former Ballan playing-coach said he was drawn to Newport because his family had a strong connection with the club – his son plays footy in the juniors and his daughter also plays netball for Newport.

"It's good to have that family connection with sport," he said.

"The lack of travel also has been an upside, as I used to commute to Ballan three times a week and those long drives can take a toll on you both physically and mentally.

"I see a lot of growth in the area and a huge opportunity to stamp Newport on the map."

The club has stated that where they finish on the ladder this season is irrelevant, they just want to be a competitive side who works for each other from the first bounce to the final siren.

Williams said his support team and all those at the club have been working hard to put together a program for their players.

"I have a strong coaching team alongside me, Jonathan Rayner brings a wealth of knowledge with him," he said.

"Billy Koutsoumbas has helped the boys with their strength and motivation and Marwan Abouzeid is tireless in his organisation of the club.

"While on the administrative front the president, Stephen Martyn, has been an enormous help with all the behind the scenes work that isn't always recognised.

"We have a solid team of people at Newport Power, so I believe the future is very bright."

The focus during summer has been fitness, skills and attitude – the three areas Williams believes is key to any footy team.

"The boys came back after the Christmas break in good shape and with positive attitudes," he said.

"It's been challenging at times as Newport hasn't had a seniors side in such a long time that we have had to really build the team from the bottom up in order to put a side together that we feel will be competitive on a regular basis."

The club appointed Mahmoud El-Hawli as captain, while Khaled ElHouli and Ziad Kadour as joint vice-captains. Jarryd Dixon and Belal Ali rounds out the leadership group for the Power's inaugural season.

The club has also been busy on the recruiting front, adding a mix of players to its list for 2016.

Junior players from their Under-18 premiership last season have also been given the chance to play in the senior side.

Tarneit hosts Newport Power at Wootten Road Reserve. The seniors start at 2.15pm.

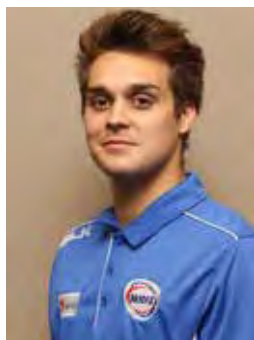

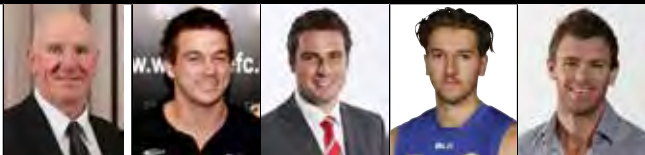
