WRFL SEASON CONTINUES TO HEAT UP

It has been an action packed first half of the year, with both senior and junior Interleague matches as well as nine rounds of thrilling football across all divisions.

In this week's issue of the Footy Record we look at all WRFL senior clubs and see

The word used most often to describe the Division 1 competition this season has been even.

There was more than 9000 reports of violence against women recorded in the west last year. This is an astonishing figure.

In the story on Page 6, Western Bulldogs Chief Executive Officer, David Stevenson says as a club they are taking an oath by promising never to commit, excuse or remain silent about violence against women.

We too are taking that oath and encourage all WRFL clubs and the wider footy community to also take that oath.

The league will be sharing information about White Ribbon's activities over the next few weeks as well as host a special White Robbin Round on July 16.

DIVISION 1



SUNSHINE

Coach's comment:

"We have certainly had our ups and highlights, but we have also in the backend of the first half of the season learnt a lot of about ourselves," coach Brendan Hallinan said. "In the second half of the year we want to win enough games.

"Overall we want to strengthen our resilience, improve our capacity to better our skills and way of playing and trust one another."



DEER PARK

Coach's comment:

"We are still work in progress, we have a new forward structure," coach Marc Bullen said. "We are sitting second at the half way break and we aren't pleased with where we are out, but our win-loss record is good enough."

"We have beaten the teams that I would say would potentially play in the finals, but we have lost to the teams at the lower end, which is probably good for the competition. "We are looking for consistency in the playing group in the second half of the season."

THE WRFL AND BULLDOGS STAND TOGETHER

THE WRFL has this year joined forces with the Western Bulldogs and White Ribbon to help raise awareness of the impact domestic violence has in the community, in particular across Melbourne's west.

Over the next six weeks, the WRFL will share information about the work White Ribbon does in the community as well as educate the league's players, coaches, officials, volunteers and supporters about what you can do to address this serious issue facing many people across the country.

The league's awareness campaign and call to action initiative will be launched in a special dedicated WRFL White Ribbon Round on July 16 and continue for the next two weeks with articles and items of interest regarding White Ribbon's activities.

The Western Bulldogs kicks off their component of the campaign with this evening's match against Geelong highlighting the devastating impact of men's violence against women, and call for change to this serious societal issue.

Western Bulldogs Chief Executive Officer, David Stevenson said the Club intended to use its voice to educate men that violence against women should not and cannot be tolerated, and called for the community to amplify this stance.

"On average, 52 women are killed per year in Australia, as a result of intimate partner violence and last year alone there were 9,000 reported incidents of violence against women in Melbourne's West."

"Those statistics are both alarming and disturbing and we feel compelled and driven to send the message that men's violence against women is simply not acceptable.

"As a Club we take the oath by promising never to commit, excuse or remain silent about violence against women, and we encourage our fans and the broader football community to do the same."

The Western Bulldogs have worked closely with the AFL, White Ribbon, Channel 7, Geelong Cats and match day partner Myer as well as the WRFL to create a campaign to highlight White Ribbon's respected

work in the community and encourage men to #StandUp #SpeakOut against domestic violence towards women and children.

Tonight's Western Bulldogs guernsey will feature the anti-violence campaign's signature White Ribbon along with a special designed match day ball — which will be signed by the coach and captain of the Bulldogs and auctioned off post-game with profits going to White Ribbon.

The match day White Ribbon themed guernseys will also be auctioned off following the return match against Geelong on Friday the 29th of July and coincides with national White Ribbon night — which encourages families to enjoy a night in and to raise important funds for White Ribbon.

ALTONA CONTINUES RUN OF GOOD FORM

ALTONA continued its great run of form in its 11.6. (72) to 5.6. (36) victory over Albion, with only percentage separating the Vikings from Hoppers Crossing and top spot.

The match up was a defensive battle, neither side kicking its fifth goal until the second half of the game.

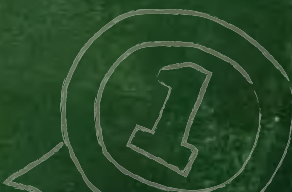

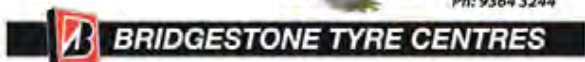

NEWPORT WIN UNDER FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS

NEWPORT have moved a game clear of second placed Albion with a comfortable 59-point win over the Wyndhamvale Falcons, 14.6. (90) to 5.1. (31), as they played under the Friday night lights at Wyndhamvale South Oval.
