SPOTSWOOD TO HONOUR BEN KELLY



THE Spotswood Football Club will today honour one of their favourite sons, Ben Kelly, who suddenly passed away earlier this month.

The western suburbs football community have been mourning the loss of Kelly, a well-loved and respected player and person who had an incredible footy career.

Ben played football at Williamstown, there he played 13 senior VFL games between 2001 and 2003.

He also played in the Reserve's' back-to-back premierships in 2002 and 2003. He was also the co-captain during that time.

Ben then made the move to Spotswood in the Western Region Football League, where he was involved in arguably the club's most successful period.

He won two best and fairest awards in 2005 and 2006 and won three premierships between 2007 and 2009 and was a part of the Woodsman's runners-up side in 2010.

More recently, he was involved with the Williamstown Juniors Football Club as the director of coaching.

Spotswood football manager, Tony Walshe, said Ben was an outstanding man.

"His leadership skills were obvious and again this shone through in his work, life and also on the football field," he said.

"His charismatic nature and love of life meant he always seemed to be enjoying what he was doing, his smile, engaging personality and sense of humour was infectious.

"He was a dedicated and loving husband to Carly and a brilliant father to his three wonderful sons, Judd, Nate and Austin."

Walshe said his impact on Spotswood, not just as a player, but as a person was enormous.

"If you never saw Ben play, think of Patrick Dangerfield, a big strong bodied midfielder, super competitive and just a winner," his said.

"As a coach and clubman he always wanted the club to improve and get better.

"He was very big on trying to get quality people to the club. Loyalty and respect were his key values"

"When you combined his playing ability with his leadership and coaching, you just knew that he would make us successful."

WRFL Football Operations manager David Newton said the WRFL Board, administration, member clubs and greater WRFL Community was deeply saddened by the sudden passing of Ben.

"Ben's contribution to the Spotswood Football Club was significant as a premiership coach and player and recently assisted the WRFL as a runner for the under-19 interleague team," he said.

"Our thoughts are with Ben's family, friends and all involved at the Spotswood Football Club."

Spotswood has planned a special tribute to honour Ben today as part of their match with St Albans at McLean Reserve.

The 2007, 2008 and 2009 premiership flags will fly at half-mast and members of Ben's family will also be in attendance.

"In one of his early speeches as coach, he stated that, when it was time leave Spotswood, he wanted it to be better than when he arrived, he certainly did that," Walshe said.

"Ben will be remembered forever at Spotswood FC as a player, coach and just as an outstanding person to know."

YOUTH GIRLS THE SHINING LIGHT AT JUNIOR CHAMPS

THE higher level of football the Western Region Football League junior Interleague teams were exposed to during the Metro Championships is set to motivate the league's young stars to be better next year, Football Operations and Club Development Officer Tim Shellcot says.

The WRFL was moved into Division 1 in 2016 after its teams earned promotion into the premier competition after a successful campaign last year.

The Western Youth Girls team, a team combined with the Essendon District Football League, was the only team to score a win during the carnival.

Shellcot said despite not getting the scores on the board, the WRFL were more than competitive in all of their matches.

"It has been a tough carnival," he admitted.

"The step up in standard with our Under-14 team and Under-15 teams has been a big challenge for all the players.

"Our talent spread has been not quite as good at the Under-13 level as it was to last year and probably the year before.

"It has been a bit of a wake up call.

"The disappointing part, is that if you looked at the scoreboard you would think we didn't do as well as we actually did.

"In some of those games we were really competitive, we probably just lacked some goal scoring power to really hurt the opposition."

This year the WRFL took on teams from the Yarra Juniors Football League, Eastern Football League and South Metro Football League.

Shellcot said despite the win-loss ratio not in the WRFL's favour the step up into Division 1 needed to happen.

"At Under-14 level in 2015, we had a really good group and we won 11 of 12 games," he said.

"They needed that promotion to get a good understanding and awareness of where they are at when they compare themselves to the big junior leagues on the other side of the city."

A shining light of the carnival was the Western Youth Girls team, who defeated the South East Juniors by 28-points.

"They had a poor first game, the second game they came close and in the third game they had a win, which was really good," Shellcot said.

"People within our clubs and our league looking at

interleague and seeing the girls having a positive interleague experience is a really good thing."

Shellcot said overall the experience would be a positive one for the league's juniors.

He said playing in Interleague could give them the motivation to work harder at club level and then in turn impress TAC Cup selectors, in particular, people from the Western Jets.

"For the Under-14 squad, interleague is an eye-opener for them, because it is really their first significant step onto the talent pathway," Shellcot said.

"The players are in a more structured program and the people coaching them, particularly the A squad, are clearly involved with the Western Jets development programs.

"It is a lightbulb moment for them."

In 2017 the WRFL will be relegated back to Division 2 in the Metro Championships.

"This will mean it will be a more even competition and the scoreboard will be a lot closer, which will ultimately be a benefit for us," Shellcot said.

"We will take on the Riddle League, the EDFL and South East Juniors."

The Under-16 team have one final match to be played against the Riddell District Football League on Wednesday in Arnold's Creek.

FOUR of the WRFL's brightest young stars will put their rivalries aside when they team-up for the School Sport Victoria team next month.

Spotswood's Ethan Bentley, Altona Juniors youngster Emerson Jeka, St Bernard's player Jeremy O'Sullivan and Werribee Districts junior Lachlan Raznovski have been picked in the Under-15 boys Victorian team.

The talented quartet, who all represented the WRFL at this year's AFL Victoria Junior Metro Championships, will travel to Maroochydore in Queensland for the Australian Football Championships.

Bentley, who attends Maribyrnong Secondary College, says he is looking forward to putting on the Big V guernsey.

He said the process to get into the Victorian team began back in April when trials for the team first opened.

"It was challenging because there was hard competition, but it was also fun to play against kids with the same ability," Bentley said.

"It means a lot to me to play for Victoria.

"It's a big step towards making higher levels."

Bentley said it was great to see other WRFL players also get picked in the team.

YOUNG GUNS PICKED IN VIC METRO SQUADS

FOUR of the WRFL's junior stars will pull on the Big V jumper tomorrow when they represent Vic Metro at the NAB AFL Under-16 National Championships.

Xavier O'Halloran from St Bernard's, Owen King from Altona Juniors, Buku Khamis from St Albans and Werribee Districts youngster Hamish Murphy have all been named to play in the carnival.

The four WRFL players, along with Keilor's Stefan Radovabovic and Darley's Zak Butters, are also a part of the Western Jets' Brad Johnson squad.

The group, pictured, are set to play against the Vic Country squad tomorrow before playing South Australia on July 4 at Metricon Stadium.

Their final game of the national championships will be against Western Australia on July 8 at Southport in Queensland.

The Western Jets are well represented in the squad, the club has the equal highest number of players in the team across the TAC Cup's metropolitan sides.

The quartet from the WRFL are familiar with each other's game, with the talented group all representing the league in last year's Junior Metro Championships.

EAGLES BLOW STORM AWAY IN WHITEWASH

THE Yarraville Seddon Eagles improved to 8-1 on the season with a dominant 69-point win over the visiting Manor Lakes Storm on Saturday.

The Eagles started off strong and never looked back, outscoring the visitors in every quarter and outplaying them all over the ground.

Yarraville Seddon received strong contributions from forward Joshua Crofton and versatile onballer Ben McCrorey, who led the team with five and three majors, respectively.

ADJUSTING TO THE AWKWARD BOUNCE OF THE BALL

By GRAEME HODGART

Quite often in a match you see players come undone by the bounce of the football. Even players who find themselves way out in the clear can struggle to gain control of the ball because it bounces awkwardly or away from them.

Umpires can also find themselves brought undone by the fickle bounce of the ball. Field umpires can get themselves into the perfect position only to see the awkward bounce of the ball send it into a completely different direction.

Over and over during a match they will have to quickly re-position themselves to be in the best position to view the play and the players.

Boundary umpires, while patrolling the boundary line, can anticipate that the ball is definitely heading for the line only to find that it takes an unexpected bounce and stays in play.

Goal umpires can make the correct positioning for a ball that is bouncing towards the scoring line only to see that an awkward bounce makes the ball change direction dramatically.

It is all part of our game mainly due to the fact of the oval shaped ball.

It does mean that the expected next-act-of-play doesn't necessarily happen and the player in the ascendancy suddenly finds themselves on the back foot.

Of course, some players are quick to re-assess the situation and try hard to get back into the play. The same goes for umpires.

The unpredictable bounce has to be quickly seen and the appropriate adjustment made.

Those umpires who can quickly respond to such a situation and are then able to get themselves into the best position for the next-act-of-play are those who usually get the next decision right.

During this weekend of games just take note of how many times players are confused or brought undone by the unkindly bounce of the football.

Even harder is to see the time that a field umpire, boundary umpire or goal umpire is caught out by the unusual behaviour of that oval ball. If you concentrate hard enough on the officiating umpires, you might see one element that makes umpiring just that little bit harder to do.

Also, a reminder that the umpires' association is organising a Farewell (to Scovell Reserve) Reunion of past and present members on Saturday, August 6 at 7pm at Scovell Reserve.

TRADE Institute of Victoria has unveiled its new Workplace Carpentry Training Facility Centre in Paramount Rd, West Footscray.

The new West Footscray venue complements TIV's excellent head office training facility located in Williamstown.

This new West Footscray facility allows for students to learn 'on the job', hands on involvement in constructing buildings 'on site' under qualified trainers and supervisors.

TIV's completion rate currently stands at 73%, which is significantly higher than the 43% completion rate construction trades as a whole experience. Full time employment rate for TIV's course participants is consistently close to 100%.

The flexibility that TIV offers in its courses is unique in comparison to other RTOs in the industry, which has allowed a number of Richmond's AFL footballers to pursue a qualification in carpentry away from the football field.
